SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF GOODS

Details are given below of the businesses that will supply goods to Newburgh residents.

When ordering products customers are advised to agree where an order can be left so that no contact is necessary. The deliverer should not come within 2 metres of the customer. This means leaving goods in porches or doorsteps and definitely not going into properties. (Deliverers can be asked to ring the doorbell using protective gloves and wait to make sure the customer knows the delivery has arrived).

Always pay by card if possible. If the only option is payment by cash this should also be left in an agreed place somewhere outside the property (or in a porch) or paid as agreed with the supplier to ensure 2 metres distancing. Try to pay the correct amount avoiding the need for change to pass hands.

Contact 01257 462352 with your order and we will put together a parcel and attempt to deliver the same day (stock levels permitting). Payment can be made by debit card, credit card or cash on delivery.

Products include fresh bread every day (except Tuesday and Sunday); milk, eggs, butter, cheese and Reynolds Butchers bacon and sausage; frozen home-made meals and pate from The Food Shop at Cedar Farm; a range of tinned and packet goods and some household cleaning items (including toilet rolls!!)

The shop opening hours will now be in line with our Post Office counter hours.

Prescription delivery

Halton's pharmacy currently provides a prescription delivery service to those who have long term conditions and cannot get to Parbold. This service will continue.

For those with long term conditions who usually pick up their own prescriptions and are no longer able to do so due to self-isolation, volunteers from Newburgh will be contacted by the pharmacy to pick up and deliver prescriptions. Volunteers will wear protective gloves to ring the doorbell, leave the package by the door, retreat to a safe distance and wait to make sure the individual answers the door.
