Coronavirus – support for residents

Newburgh village organisations are looking for ways of providing support for residents during the coronavirus outbreak.

The aim is to help people who are isolated and may need help to do shopping, get food, collect medicines, make contact with friends or run errands. It will not offer any form of medical advice which is in the hands of the NHS.

We ask residents who are able to offer support to identify themselves via email to the Newburgh Parish Clerk or any of the organisations overleaf so that we can compile a village-wide network of contacts for residents to call upon if they need help. We will publish the list of volunteers through a printed Newburgh Newsletter and need your written consent to have your contact details made public in this way. For personal protection, names of volunteers will not be published on social media.

We will also discuss with service and goods suppliers whether any arrangements can be made to deliver direct to residents. If you have a service or goods you can provide or deliver please also let any of the contacts overleaf know.

We will keep residents up-to-date on any further sources of help via Facebook.com/newburghlancs as well as through notices on the Notice Boards and through further Newburgh Newsletters delivered to all homes.
